3. Use "verb" for printing commands, for example:

The command `top` shows all running processes including PID, USERNAME, ... TIME, CPU, COMMAND sorted by CPU usage

`top -U username` shows only the processes of user "username"

Type `k` and then the PID to kill a process with the given PID.

To enforce the termination of a process, meaning it will not be asked to close, but instantly killed, use `kill -9 PID`
